ROY WATER CONSERVANCY CUSTOMERS

We will begin to fill the Secondary Water Lines the week of **April 12 to April 16, 2010**, unless we are experiencing a great deal of precipitation. It may take up to two (2) days to fill all the lines and a week or more to repair any damaged mains. We are asking that you refrain from watering your lawn until the first of May, or for as long as possible. Normally, the water season runs from the middle of April until the middle of October, depending on the weather, but may be shortened as soon as the first of October. If you would like to receive email notification of the beginning & end of the water season, please send a request to roywater2@roywater.com and we'll keep you informed!

Water Conservation – Please remember, **ABSOLUTELY NO WATERING BETWEEN 10:00 A.M. to 6:00 P.M.** We are asking all customers to please practice water conservation by watering during the cooler times of the day. This is better for your lawns and plants. Do not leave the water on for long periods of time. Adjust your sprinklers so they water only the landscaped area, not sidewalks, driveways, or streets. (Exceptions will be made for new sod or seed.)

Property Owner's Responsibility – Close your gate valve before April 1st. Gate valves are the property owner's responsibility to repair and maintain. The owner is responsible for any damage caused, either to their property or to neighboring properties, by problems with their sprinkler system.

Emergency and After Business Hours – If you have any questions pertaining to the system or notice any water leaks, call the **District at (801) 825-9744** between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. If it is an emergency and **after business hours**, call the **Roy City Police at (801) 629-8221**. They will page the person on emergency call. However, the night of April 13, 2010, our office will remain open until at least 12:00 midnight for calls.
