The existing parcel has not had an existing water allotment. The developer will be required to bring either one half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) share of D&WCCC stock, one half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) share of Wilson Irrigation stock or an appropriate amount of Hooper Irrigation shares in order to supply the secondary water needs of the development. The developer will be required to install one (1) 1-inch meter for the project. Otherwise, this is a standard development agreement.
